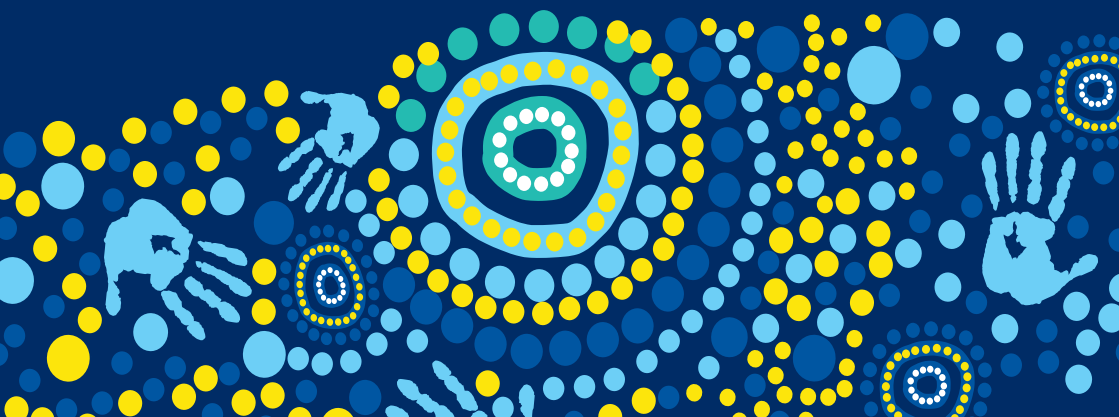

HOW TO USE THIS GUIDE

The purpose of the First Nations Resource Guide ('Guide') is to provide members, volunteers and employees with a resource that will support implementation of the Society's Reconciliation Action Plan.

First, the Guide provides a comprehensive list of Aboriginal Community Controlled Organisations (ACCO's) in NSW and their contact details. Each ACCO in the list is organised according to their Central Council location. A colour-coded icon  displays to the left of the name of each ACCO, which indicates the type of service offered by the ACCO. The chart below displays nine categories of service type.

Second, where an ACCO provides a diverse and inclusive service, the Guide will display one of three icons  to the right of the name of the ACCO. Since from time-to-time ACCO's may start up or wind up, users of the Guide are encouraged to obtain a current list of ACCOs by consulting the Office of the Registrar of Indigenous Corporations website.

Finally, the Guide displays a comprehensive list of the names of Local Aboriginal Land Councils (LALCs) in NSW. The list of LALCs displays according to the Regions established by the Aboriginal Lands Act 1983 (NSW):Schedule 5.

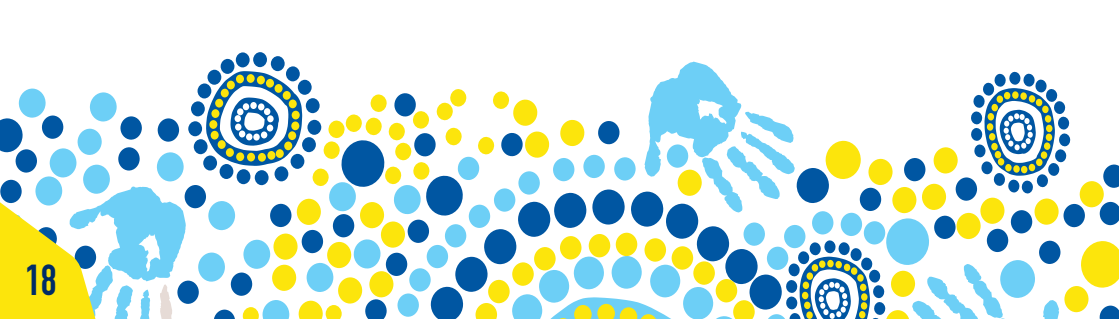

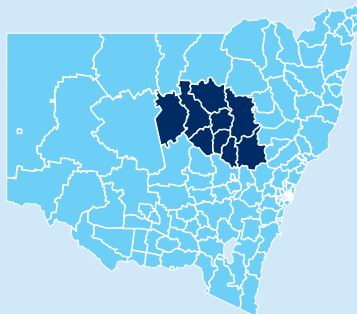
Local Aboriginal Land Councils advocate for the rights of Aboriginal People and communities.

However, the responses that Society Personnel who engage with LALCs encounter may vary. It is important to consider, beforehand, why you wish to reach out to a Land Council on behalf of the Society, and how to do so in a manner that is respectful of Aboriginal culture, local Aboriginal customs and local kin relationship networks.
